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The Talking Page™ Literacy Organization has announced that the Early Linguistics and Family Literacy Program by Talking Page™ Kit will be available to pre-schools, Headstart programs, and school readiness programs. The program was introduced at Garfield Elementary School in Santa Ana, CA, in December 2001, funded by a special grant from the Children and Families Commission of Orange County, part of First Five California. The “program” uses a neurolinguistic instruction method and the SONO Audio System. The neurolinguistic instruction method is how the brain processes oral and written language. The SONO audio system enables the teacher to instruct 100 pre school students in the same manner. The teacher’s book I is divided into 12 three minute SONO Audio lessons, which teach the sounds of the 26 letters of the English alphabet and Dialogic Reading section, which develops oral language skills. For parents, the sounds of the 44 common letter combinations of the English alphabet, the spelling of English words by dictation, and the writing of sentences using proper grammar. Teacher’s book II continues for parents with 68 lessons of building spelling vocabulary, sentence writing, English grammar instruction, and reading and comprehension tests for grades 1-5 and 6-11. The “kit” also contains an English Linguistics phonemes pre and post test, CA state standards individual student pre-K learning plans, a SONO player model 441 with headphone/microphones, a classroom storage box, and a teacher’s travel tote bag.
